#### **MODULE 4**

<u>Day 8– Task 14</u> : Making a Bridal Bouquet	

### **Tools and Materials Required:**

Tools: Glue Gun/Glue Stick

Materials: 8" Styrofoam ball

9" piece of pvc pipe ¾ "

Flowers/lace/accessories

#### **<u>Lesson</u>**: Bridal Bouquets History:

The practice of brides carrying bouquets dates to ancient times. The Greeks and Romans, even Egyptians, carried fragrant herbs and spices to ward off bad luck during weddings. Flowers symbolize a new beginning and brings hopes of fertility, happiness, and fidelity. As times progressed brides used flowers to communicate their romantic sentiments through their specific floral choices, that practice has faded a bit, with modern couples choosing their flowers based more on beauty and colour.

Preparation of Work Space -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

#### **Instructions**

- 1. Cut your 8" Styrofoam ball in half.
- 2. You will be working with only half.

Floral wire/flowers/greenery/ 2 thin green leaf

- 3. Take you PVC pipe and push it into the center of your Styrofoam ball about 2" up making an impression, now remove the pipe.
- 4. Scoop out a little of the Styrofoam so that it have a small sink at the bottom.
- 5. Cut a 7" circle piece of satin cover the bottom area of you Styrofoam ball there will be extra fabric at the sides, stick it up towards the ball
- 6. Cut out the center hold of your fabric which you had previously make at step 4 take the pvc pipe and replace it through the satin and through the Styrofoam ball securing it properly using you glue gun.
- 7. Cut a piece of satin 2 ½ "round, place it at the bottom of the PVC pipe to cover the open area let the extras to toward the PVC pipe.
- 8. Take ½ " ribbon starting at the top twisting it all around do not let your pvc pipe show

# continue until you reach the bottom. 9. Place your bling around the base of your Styrofoam ball. 10. Cut all your stem 1" off your flowers stick it inside the Styrofoam ball. Pull it out, put glue on the stem insert it back inside the Styrofoam ball. 11.
