<u>Day 8 – Task 15</u> : Making a Bridal Bouquet

Tools and Materials Required:

Tools: Glue Gun/Glue Stick

Materials: 9" metal ring, Floral wire/flowers/greenery/ 2 thin green leaf

<u>Lesson</u>: Bridal Bouquets with metal rings:

- Are for Unconventional Brides
- Endless Options

Preparation of Work Space -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

Instructions

- 1. Place your 2 thin greenery leaf, one left and one right at the bottom of your ring, using floral wire to secure the leaf
- 2. Put your desired flower on the top of the greenery at that point you can use 18" lengths of ribbons to fall.
- 3. You will be left with part of the center of your ring where you can be able to hold on to.
- 4. Your Bouquet is finished.
