Day 8 – Task 15: Making a Bridal Bouquet

Tools and Materials Required:

Tools: Glue Gun/Glue Stick

Materials: 9” metal ring, Floral wire/flowers/greenery/ 2 thin green leaf

Lesson: Bridal Bouquets with metal rings:

- **Are for Unconventional Brides**
- **Endless Options**

Preparation of Work Space -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

Instructions

1. Place your 2 thin greenery leaf, one left and one right at the bottom of your ring, using floral wire to secure the leaf
2. Put your desired flower on the top of the greenery at that point you can use 18" lengths of ribbons to fall.
3. You will be left with part of the center of your ring where you can be able to hold on to.
4. Your Bouquet is finished.
