MODULE 3

Day 5 – Task 8: Making/Decorating a Cake Box

Tools and Materials Required:

Tools: Glue Gun/Glue Stick, Cardboard/ embellishments

Lesson: Cakeboxes can be :

- For All Occasions
- Custom Created

Preparation of Work Space -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

Instructions

1. Take a piece of cardboard, using a tuna can draw out the round bottom of the can cut out that circle.
2. Cover the bottom of your circle cardboard with fabric or gift paper.
3. Cut a piece of cardboard 1" by the circumference of the circle (cardboard) leaving overlap of $\frac{3}{4}$ ".
4. Cover the 1" piece of cardboard with fabric or gift paper.
5. Join the 1" cardboard to the circle piece of cardboard, now you would have a shape just like the tuna can.
6. Line the inside of your box with fabric or gift paper.
7. Use a sweetie bag rip out the thread from the bottom of the bag and place the open area over the circle box you made using your glue gun.
8. Now put embellishments around the can hiding the raw edges of the bag.
9. Get a piece of tulle, and wrap your cake inside the tulle then place it inside the cake bag.

Your Cake Box is finished.
