### MODULE 7

Day 13- Task 24: Rosette

## **Tools and Materials Required:**

Tools: Stapler

Materials:

- 3" piece of cardboard
- Kite paper

Lesson : Rosette

**Preparation of Work Space** -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

## **Instructions**

- 1. Fold kite paper in half and cut. Now you are only working with half.
- Fold your paper in half and complete this step for 4 times. Therefore, you will be folding in half 5 times in total.
- 3. Start at the center of your square/rectangle and cut in a scallop shape going upward and around to the end of the left side of the kite paper. See Figure 1 for product. You **must** of 18 pieces of the scalloped shaped kite paper.
- 4. Take the 3" piece of cardboard and staple the 18



- pieces of scalloped kite paper at the center.
- 5. Using 2 scalloped papers, bring upwards to the center, giving a slight crunch.
- 6. Take another 2 and repeat step 5. Continue this process 4 times, leaving the remaining scalloped papers flat on the cardboard base.

Your project is completed.
