MODULE 7

Day 13– Task 25: Centerpiece (using a Hurricane glass)

Tools and Materials Required:

Tools: Glue gun/Glue stick

Materials:

- 1 Hurricane glass
- 3 yards of ribbon, 2” wide
- Needle and thread to match ribbon

Lesson : : Centerpiece (using a Hurricane glass)

Preparation of Work Space -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

Instructions

1. Wrap ribbon once around at top of the glass, leaving ¼" overlap, then cut.
2. Stick the ¼" overlap of the ribbon to glass.
3. Take the remaining ribbon that is not stuck to the glass and cut in half.
4. Take 1 piece of ribbon and run a basting stitch along the length. Then pull the basting stitch to make a rosette. Tie off. Repeat this step for the next ribbon. You will now have 2 rosettes.
5. Place both rosettes on each side of the ribbon that is already stuck to the glass.

Your project is completed.
