### **MODULE 8**

#### **Day 16– Task 30: Chairs/Pews/Walls**

#### **Tools and Materials Required:**

Tools: Glue Gun/Glue stick

Materials:

- ¼” yard of satin
- Cardboard
- Needle and thread
- ½ sheet of ¼” sponge
- Flowers, 24” tulle, ½” wide ribbons

#### **Lesson : Chairs/Pews/Walls**

**Preparation of Work Space** -Always ensure work area is clean, and only equipment and materials to be used should be on the table/counter.

## **Instructions**

1. Cut 9" circle from the cardboard. Locate the center of the 9" circle and draw a 2 ½" circle in circumference. Cut out 2 ½" circle from center. You will now have a donut shape cardboard.
2. Wrap donut shape cardboard, with sponge all around, passing the sponge inside out, until you reach your starting point.
3. Cut satin in 2" strips and wrap sponge inside out until you reach your starting point.
4. Measure 24" long on tulle and cut straight through the fabric.
5. Take needle and thread, run a base stitch along width at the top of the tulle.
6. Pull the basing thread to 9" and tie off.
7. Place 9" gathered tulle around the center at the bottom edge of the inner covered donut.  
**Tip:** Do not let tulle pass the halfway mark on either side of the donut.
8. Cut 4, 20" pieces of ½" ribbon and 4 pieces of 9" ribbon.
9. Gather all the pieces of ribbon together, and glue to secure ribbon at the center of the 9" gathered tulle on the donut. **Tip:** Ribbon must be full.
10. Place 1 flower at the top center of the ribbons, and place greenery; one left, one right of the flower.
11. Then place another flower; one left, one right of the greenery done at step 10.
12. Place greenery left and right of the flower you placed at step 11.
13. Wrap bling around the top inner circle at the center of the donut as you desire.

Your project is completed.
